A launch pad for your child's future

An extraordinary part of London is taking shape at King's Cross. One of the UK's largest and most successful regeneration projects is transforming King's Cross, with all its heritage and history, into a thriving new place with a growing, diverse community.

At the heart of this exciting change is the new King's Cross Academy – a purpose built primary school that offers a unique opportunity for your child to make the most of his or her potential.

Located in the Plimsoll Building, the Academy will open its doors in September 2015. In its first year, the primary school will have two reception classes for up to 60 children and a 26-place nursery for 3 to 5 year old children.

As the King's Cross community continues to grow, the Academy will expand over time to serve 420 primary school pupils aged 4 to 11, plus the nursery.

King's Cross Academy is being developed and run by the same people who are behind the wider King's Cross regeneration. We want to give our pupils the best possible education and access to opportunities, so they leave school with the achievements, aspiration and confidence to be successful at secondary school and beyond.

This brochure outlines our vision for King's Cross Academy and your children's education. If you have a child starting school or nursery in September 2015 and you live in the area, we hope you will become one of the first members of the King's Cross Academy community.

Our smart new school

A location for the future

King's Cross Academy will be housed in the first two floors of the award-winning new Plimsoll Building, in the heart of King's Cross. The building is named after Samuel Plimsoll, a politician and social reformer in Victorian Britain and a coal merchant at King's Cross.

The Plimsoll Building overlooks a beautiful new park, framed by the historic guide frame of Gasholder No.8. The Gasholder is the inspiration for our school emblem. It encapsulates both the industrial past of King's Cross and its new, creative future. Dating back to 1850, the guide frame is now Grade II listed. It has been carefully refurbished and re-located alongside the Regent's Canal to form a new, well-managed public space.

A State-Of-The-Art Learning Environment

Light and airy, the Academy space has been designed to create a wonderful environment for our pupils to learn and play in.

The Academy will be equipped with the latest technology for learning, an inspiring library and specialist food and design technology rooms. It will also have a virtual learning environment, to which our pupils and their parents will be able to connect from home.

We intend to prepare fresh food for the children daily, in our own kitchens. Physical learning will feature highly and children will have access to a multi-level playground, a secure multi-use games area in the building opposite and the adjacent Gasholder park. In addition, public swimming pools and green spaces are a short walk away, including Camley Street Natural Park, a local nature reserve.

The School Day

The Academy will run an extended school day, including a breakfast club and after school activities. Further details will be available on our website in due course.

Uniform

Working with parents

The active involvement of parents is vital to children's learning and the life of the Academy. Parents and carers will always be welcome at the school and will be invited to regular coffee mornings with the Head Teacher and governors. They will also have opportunities to come along on school trips and classroom visits.

Our Partner School

The Academy has an onsite nursery, with its own dedicated indoor and outdoor spaces (and its own admission arrangements).

Our partnership with the Frank Barnes School for Deaf Children (an existing, outstanding school) will provide a rare opportunity for our pupils to learn British Sign Language as part of our broad, balanced and creative curriculum.

Frank Barnes School will share facilities onsite as well as having its own dedicated facilities within the building.

We aim to prepare children for the modern world by making them highly successful life-long learners. Our learning vision has four principal themes:

Teaching pupils how to learn

King's Cross Academy will teach pupils how to learn – encouraging qualities such as persistence, resilience, resourcefulness and flexibility – so that they develop a lifetime love of learning. We will help children learn how to question, think creatively and become active learners and communicators.

A broad, balanced and creative curriculum

The Academy will provide children with a complete education. The Academy will take a rigorous approach to the teaching of Mathematics and English, as part of a broad and balanced, project-based curriculum. We will promote children's skills in listening, speaking, thinking and questioning and develop their social and emotional skills.

Creating an environment that promotes learning

It matters where and how education takes place. We will draw upon the exceptional environment within and around this new school to provide activities and opportunities that inspire, excite and transform the learning of children, their parents and other adults in the community.

Developing children to be leaders

The King's Cross Academy will develop children's leadership by building their capacity to make reasoned decisions and choices. Our pupils will be encouraged to use their initiative, whilst working in productive partnership with others. We want children to gain confidence in their own abilities and their ability to learn and improve; and be emotionally engaged in their learning. We want our school to be a catalyst for positive change for all in the King's Cross community.

Our Chair of Governors, Robert Evans, is a director of KCCLP and has played a lead role in the regeneration of King's Cross for more than a decade. As a father of two primary school-age children, he is passionate and ambitious for what the Academy can achieve.




Applications for the Academy must be made via the Camden admissions department at 5 Pancras Square, London N1C 4AG. You can also apply online at www.eadmissions.org.uk
